Secondary colors: Orange, Green, Violet
Intermediate colors: Red-orange, Red-violet, Bluegreen, Blue-violet, Yellow-green, Yellow-orange
Neutral colors: Black, White, Gray, Brown
If I add WHITE to a color, it will become lighter.
This is called a tint.
If I add BLACK to a color, it will become darker.
This is called a shade.
